About U.S. Craft Brewing:*

- Craft brewers currently provide an estimated 108,440 jobs in the U.S., including serving staff in brewpubs.
- Growth of the craft brewing industry by volume was 15% in 2012, compared to 13% in 2011.
- Craft brewers sold an estimated 13,235,917 barrels of beer in 2012, up from 11,467,337 in 2011.
- Overall, U.S. beer sales were up an estimated 0.9% by volume in 2012.
- The craft brewing sales share in 2012 was 6.5% by volume and 10.2% by dollars.
- 2,347 craft breweries operated for some or all of 2012, comprised of 1,132 brewpubs, 1,118 microbreweries and 97 regional craft breweries.

Montana Brewers:

- Utilize over 5000 retailers, and sell their products in 24 states.
- Produce over 300 brands of beer that are sold throughout the state.
- Manufacture and package over 110,000 barrels (3,410,000 gallons) of fine handcrafted beer in pints, bottles, cans, and kegs each year.
- Use over 6 million pounds of malted grain, approximately half of which is grown in Montana.
- Had a positive impact of over \$50,000,000 on Montana's economy.
- Experienced a 10% growth in barrels of beer produced in 2012.
- Employ more than 350 Montanans.
- Employ the staff of dozens of trade companies statewide such as plumbers, electricians, refrigeration, and general contractors.
