About U.S. Craft Brewing:*

- Craft brewers currently provide an estimated 110,273 jobs, an increase of almost 2,000 from 2012.
- Growth of the craft brewing industry by volume was 18% in 2013 (15,600,000 barrels), compared to 15% in 2012 (13,200,000 barrels).
- Craft dollar share of the total U.S. beer market reached 14.3 percent in 2013, as retail dollar value from craft brewers was estimated at \$14.3 billion, up from \$11.9 billion in 2012.
- Craft beer has now averaged 10.9 percent growth per year over the last decade.
- In 2013, craft brewers reached 7.8 percent volume of the total U.S. beer market, up from 6.5 percent in 2012.
- The number of operating breweries in the U.S. in 2013 totaled 2,822, with 2,768 of those considered craft, demonstrating that craft breweries make up 98 percent of all U.S. operating breweries.

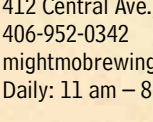

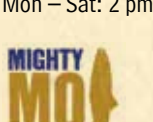

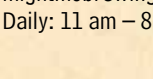
