### Montana Brewers:

- Utilize over 5000 retailers, and sell their products in 24 states.
- Produce over 300 brands of beer that are sold throughout the state.
- Manufacture and package over 105,000 barrels (3,255,000 gallons) of fine handcrafted beer in pints, bottles, cans, and kegs each year.
- Use over 6 million pounds of malted grain, approximately half of which is grown in Montana.
- Distribute products through Montana's beer and wine wholesale distributors.
- Experienced a 13% growth in barrels of beer produced in 2011.
- Employ more than 250 Montanans.
- Employ the staff of dozens of trade companies statewide such as plumbers, electricians, refrigeration, and general contractors.



### About U.S. Craft Brewing:

- Craft brewers currently provide an estimated 103,500 jobs in the U.S., including serving staff in brewpubs.
- Growth of the craft brewing industry by volume was 13% in 2011, compared to 11% in 2010.
- Craft brewers sold an estimated 11,468,152 barrels of beer in 2011, up from 10,133,571 in 2010.
- Overall, U.S. beer sales were down an estimated 1.3% by volume in 2011.
- The craft brewing sales share in 2011 was 5.7% by volume and 9.1% by dollars.
- 1,940 craft breweries operated for some or all of 2011, comprised of 1,063 brewpubs, 789 microbreweries and 88 regional craft breweries.
