Montana Brewers:

- Utilize over 5000 retailers, and sell their products in 24 states.
- Produce over 300 brands of beer that are sold throughout the state.
- Manufacture and package over 88,000 barrels (2,728,000 gallons) of fine handcrafted beer in pints, bottles, cans, and kegs each year.
- Use over 5.6 million pounds of malted grain, approximately half of which is grown in Montana.
- Distribute products through Montana's beer and wine wholesale distributors.
- Experienced an 10% growth in barrels of beer produced in 2010.
- Employ more than 240 Montanans.
- Employ the staff of dozens of trade companies statewide such as plumbers, electricians, refrigeration, and general contractors.



About U.S. Craft Brewing:

- Craft brewers currently provide an estimated 100,000 jobs in the U.S., including serving staff in brewpubs.
- Growth of the craft brewing industry by volume was 11% in 2010, compared to 7.2% in 2009.
- Overall, U.S. beer sales were down an estimated 1.0% by volume in 2010.
- Craft brewers sold an estimated 9,951,956 barrels of beer in 2010, up from 8,934,446 in 2009.
- The craft brewing sales share in 2010 was 4.9% by volume and 7.6% by dollars.
- 1,753 breweries operated for some or all of 2010, the highest total since the late-1800s.
