





GOVERNMENT ADVOCACY

- Your membership in the MBA allows us to advocate for the interests of Montana's craft brewing industry at all levels of the policymaking process, including:
 - Lobbying at the Montana State Legislature
 - Representing brewers during the administrative rulemaking process
 - Weighing in with local government as needed
 - Working with industry partners to find common ground and head off threats

• Recent MBA policy victories include:

- 2024 Secured changes to proposed DOR rules that could be interpreted to eliminate delivery and advertising privileges for brewers with a colocated licenses and spousal closely-held license ownership
- 2023 Expanded the Academic Brewer License (allowing brewing at MSU Barley, Malt and Brewing Quality Lab)
- 2023 Increased retail privileges to allow brewers to serve collaboration beers
- 2023 Created new retail opportunity through license stacking
- 2021 Clarified law to allow brewers to produce hard seltzers
- 2021 Permit curbside delivery
- 2021 Allow a spouse to own a closely-held license
- 2020 Executive orders, including curbside delivery and expanded outdoor seating, to keep breweries afloat during COVID-19 shutdown
